The Unaltered Augsburg Confession



June 25 is the 487th anniversary of the presentation of the Augsburg Confession. This was the statement of faith and doctrine of

the Lutherans. Philip Melancthon was the lead writer and presenter, since Martin Luther was still an outlaw and could not travel to Augsburg. It was, and still is today, one of the primary statements of faith in our church body.
