Ministry Action Teams and Opportunities

What are ministry action teams?

Ministry Action Teams are groups of members and friends of Trinity Lutheran Church and School that work to carry out the mission and ministries of Trinity. These teams form around specific events, activities and services and become the primary drivers to get those goals accomplished.

What kinds of things are being done?

Each team is comprised of a leader and group of volunteers. They may form because someone has a heart for a particular ministry, such as our Community of Needs meals, or they may form at the request of a pastor or the principal. Many of these groups are involved in making our worship services go smoothly, groups such as altar guild, soundboard operators, ushers, greeters, choir and praise band, acolytes, and candle fillers. Many support the school, such as boosters club, lunch room volunteers and golf outing fundraisers. Ministry Action Teams typically fall under one of these categories: Member Support, Missions and Outreach, School Support, and Worship Support.

How does the program work?

The teams are approved and cheered on by the Administrative Team (pastors, principal, and finance manager) so that this vital work is aligned with our congregation's core values and the ministry plan for each year. Leaders are asked to complete a form in January that lists activities from the previous year, plans for the current year, and special requests for funding, meeting space, promotional materials and/or additional volunteers.
